- o **Female** mostly **Chocolate Lab** who is **about 11 months old**
- o 50 lbs now and probably will **mature to ~55 lbs**
- o **Abused** and abandoned mid-November at the Hollister shelter (physical scars have healed; emotional scars are improving: she is timid and shys from strangers, quick movement, and noises)
- o **Sweet, loving, soft and cuddly** "lap dog" who is trying hard to trust people again.
- o **Very friendly/submissive with other dogs** (shares toys/bones/beds and plays well)
- o No signs of any aggression even if cornered (**no fear aggression** nor food aggression)
- o Very willing to please so quickly learned **delightful manners**: housebroken, crate trained, quiet, sleeps all night, good in car/travel, eats anything, gently takes treats from hands, can touch/handle easily
- o Progressing on **training**. OK on leash and learning sit/down. Willingly comes when call her name.
- o Vet work done: **spayed, microchipped, shots, heartworm tested and de-wormed.**



Cocoa will be a loyal companion to someone who gives her time to gain her trust. If you want to **make a difference in a dog's life, this little girl would undoubtedly be grateful and melt your heart with her willingness to forgive people.** She would be best in a home with other animals (she gains confidence following other dogs and has been fine around cats) and without young children (she's not aggressive towards children but gets more fearful around fast people movement).
